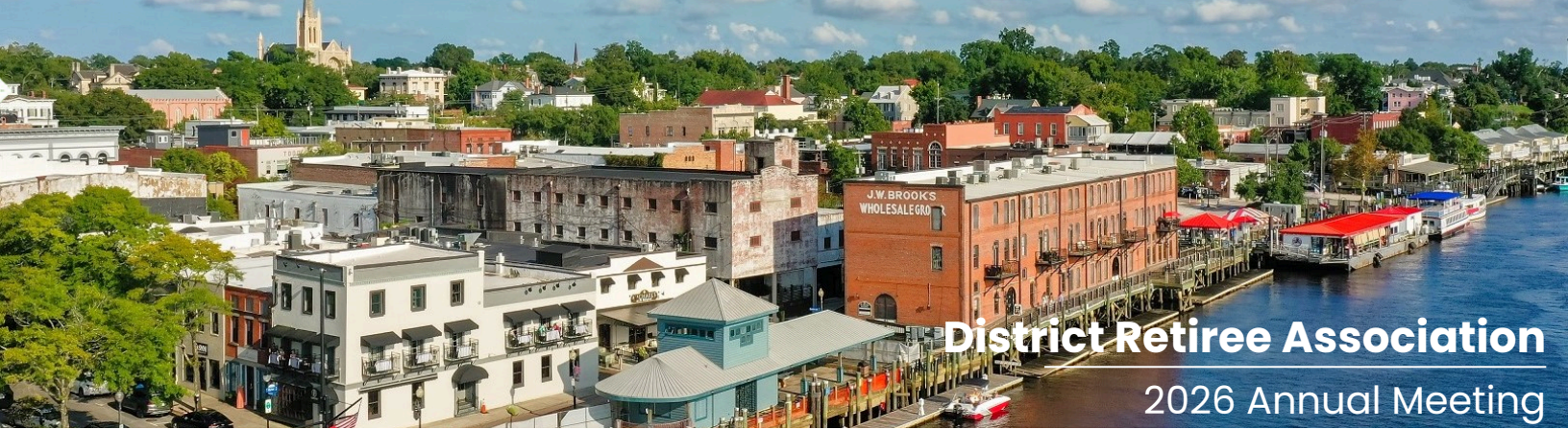

AREA ATTRACTIONS



Tuesday afternoon is a great opportunity to explore the local area. Here are a few ideas and locations to consider:

Stroll along the Riverwalk and enjoy a breathtaking view of the Cape Fear River. Stop into an assortment of markets, unique boutiques, art galleries and independently owned outdoor cafés and restaurants that line the two-mile scenic walkway, all set against a picturesque river backdrop. Or explore the area's historic roots on a self-guided or carriage ride of downtown's National Register Historic District.



Tour the decks of the World War II-era Battleship North Carolina, named one of the "Best Museum Ships" by USA TODAY, and experience how the sailors lived aboard the ship during wartime.

Get lost in Airlie Gardens' 67 acres of formal gardens, walking trails, seasonal blooms, centuries-old oak trees, artistic sculptures and more. Spy over 200 species of birds that have been observed within the gardens, see the famous Airlie Oak –the largest Live Oak in North Carolina at 128 feet high.



Find free spirited, laid-back good times at one of Wilmington's three islands: Carolina Beach, Kure Beach and Wrightsville Beach. A vintage seaside boardwalk, miles of pristine sand and world-class fishing can all be found at these authentic Carolina beaches.
